

Rules & Regulations

- 1) One vehicle per entry and up to 100 marchers per entry. Car Club entry fees cover 12 cars riding in tandem. Each vehicle will receive their own entry number. Vehicles without entry numbers will be refused entry to the Parade Route. Each additional vehicle or set of marchers will require written prior approval from the Director of Parades & additional entry fees.
- 2) No alcoholic beverages or carrying of cans or glass bottles is allowed in the Staging areas or on the Parade route. There are no exceptions.
- 3) Please maintain continuous forward movement by ensuring all routines are forward moving/marching. Please do not stop along the route for special recognition or exhibition, unless directed by Parade Staff.
- 4) All motorized units over 20 feet in length and/or vehicles with children 13 years of age or younger riding are required to have a minimum of two walkers on each side of the vehicle for safety.
- 5) All vehicles in the Parade must have current automobile coverage.
- 6) Motorized units, floats and units with generators must carry a fire extinguisher.
- 7) Weapons, firearms, and/or explosives, including firecrackers, silly string & confetti will not be allowed.
- 8) All live animal units MUST have their own cleanup crew to pick up droppings in the Staging area and along the Parade route.
- 9) All entries must reflect good taste and adhere to the Parade theme. Inappropriate dress, behavior, music and/or disruption of the event could result in removal from the Parade. Music must be radio edit version.
- 10) For reasons of public safety, please limit your use of air/car horns on the parade route. Frequent horn blaring is not allowed as it may interfere with the operations of police and emergency vehicles.
- 11) To ensure the safety of children and people seated along the parade route, please refrain from loud revving of engines and burnouts.
- 12) Please make way for emergency vehicles and cooperate with police and all Parade staff.

Drill Team/Drumline Rules

- 1) All team members must check in on time and in designated line up position. The team must remain in designated area until instructed to move by parade director/staff.
- 2) Teams are to keep a steady movement to keep the flow of the parade.
- 3) Any persons not in uniform will not be able to follow the team. All staff must have on a uniform or t-shirt that identifies them as part of the team.
- 4) No unauthorized vehicles. All vehicles must be registered with the Parade Committee.
- 5) Any fighting, arguing, violence, sabotaging of another team will automatically disqualify your entire team/drumline and will be arrested/escorted away from the event by site security staff/KCPD.

Failure to comply with the above listed requirements in the Staging area and/or along the Parade route will result in immediate removal from the Parade and/or exclusion from future Parades. If you are removed from the Parade, no refunds will be given.
